

Visitor Guidelines

In accordance with ACT 311

We recognize that visitors are an important part of the patient experience. SARH is continuing to take proactive steps to protect our patients, team members, and community with enhanced cleaning precautions, screening measures, and visitor restrictions. Some of our areas may have slightly different restrictions; please see below for more details regarding visitor restrictions throughout the hospital.

WHEN VISITING, PLEASE ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES:

- Do not enter the hospital if you are exhibiting any signs or symptoms of COVID.
- Sanitize hands when entering the hospital and when entering or exiting patient rooms.

Patient Type	Guidelines-PER DAY	Overnight Visitor
Inpatient & Outpatient areas not including ED and ICU	Visitors are allowed daily between the hours of 7:00 am and 8:00 pm. Visitors are not limited, as long as, the visit does not interfere with the care of the patient or the recovery experience of other patients.	If the patient is a minor or needs special assistance, one person will be permitted to stay overnight.
ICU	Visitors are allowed daily between the hours of 11am-1pm and 6pm-8pm. One visitor is allowed at a time.	Overnight visitors are not allowed in ICU.
Women's Center	Two designated visitors will be allowed during labor and delivery. After delivery, downstairs at postpartum more visitors are allowed. Siblings of all ages are welcome. Visitors under 14 years of age are not allowed.	One of the two designated visitors is allowed to stay the night.
ER	Patient will be allowed two support people. Support person must be over the age of 15.	N/A
Behavioral Health Unit	Monday –Friday, 5:30 – 6:30 pm Saturday and Sunday, 2:00 –4:00 pm	N/A
Hospice	Visitation 24/7	Enter through Emergency room.
